Executive Summary

The Glass Block Bopoma Dam Project represents a transformative water infrastructure initiative designed to address Bulawayo's critical water shortage. Located 70km southeast of Zimbabwe's second-largest city, this strategically positioned dam and pipeline system will deliver 68 million litres per day, ensuring water security for over 650,000 residents while catalyzing regional economic development.

Critical Problem

- · Current water deficit: 28.4 MI/day
- Projected deficit by 2035: 75+ MI/day
- Demand (165 MI/day) exceeds supply (136.4 MI/day)
- Threatens economic growth and public health

Strategic Solution

- 129 million m³ capacity dam
- 32km pipeline to existing waterworks
- 68 MI/day sustainable yield
- Cost-effective at \$0.90/m³
